2. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or above on a 4.0 scale by February 1 in the year of graduation to apply.
3. Applicant must complete an official Southeast District Scholarship Application by deadline date, **March 1, 2017**.
4. Applicant must submit a typed 300 word essay on the following topic: **How Has President Barack Obama and His Family Impacted Your Life and Educational Goals?**

Scholarship Package must include the following:

1. Completed Scholarship Application (typed or printed clearly)
Note – **Late or Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
2. Resume that includes: career goals, GPA, academic awards or honors received, community involvement, special skills and extracurricular activities
3. Enclose a small photo
4. Two character letters of recommendation (teacher, counselor, principal, other)
5. Transcript of latest semester with the official school seal
6. College entrance exam scores (SAT or ACT) if applicable

All application packages must be received by the deadline - **March 1, 2017**.
